
Coach Bio - Travis Martin was hired by the Conewago Valley School District as a Health, Phys Ed and Drivers Education teacher and the head boys and girls tennis coach in 2005. In 17 seasons under Martin, the Colonials have been on a surge of success taking the program from a 1-2 wins a year program to a consistent league and district contender. Coach Martin's first coaching stint came at East Stroudsburg University. Martin helped coach the ESU Warriors tennis team and was their main Strength and Conditioning coach. Martin graduated with



high honors and was awarded the prestigious President's Service award at East Stroudsburg University. During 2004, Martin also competed in the North American Ironman Championship at Lake Placid, NY in a time of 10 hours 59 minutes. Coach was a 4-year starter and letter winner at the ESU division 2 program. Martin was a 3-time captain and played number one 3 of the 4 years. 


