
Message from the Athletic Director

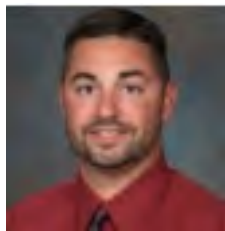

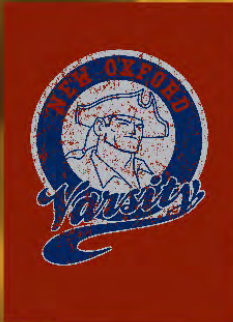


A Message From The Principal

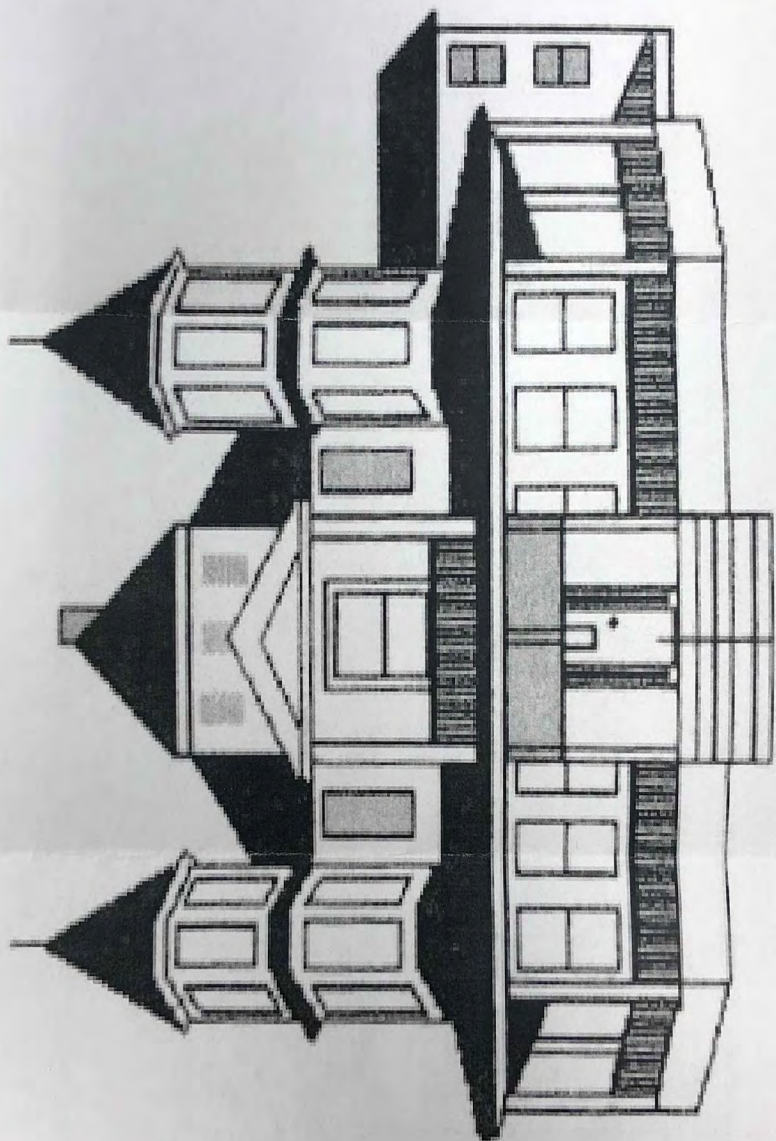


Chris Arendt
