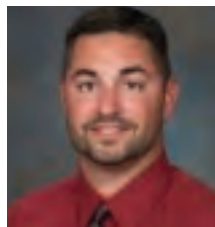

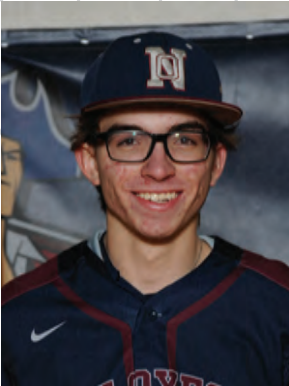

## **Coach Bio - Scott Anderson**

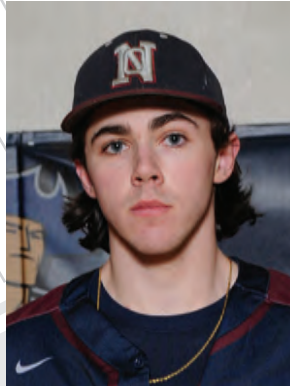

During 2004, Martin also competed in the North American Ironman Championship at Lake Placid, NY in a time of 10 hours 59 minutes. Coach was a 4-year starter and letter winner at the ESU division 2 program. Martin was a 3-time captain and played number one 3 of the 4 years. He received 3 coaches awards and 1 MVP award as a tennis player at ESU. A native to Adams county, Martin played high school tennis at Gettysburg High School. He also competed on the soccer and wrestling teams. Martin was fortunate enough to experience districts and captainship for each sport. In 1999, Martin's wrestling team finished 1st in the district. Martin's high school tennis career came to a halt by losing to a state qualifier in 3 sets during the district singles tournament.
