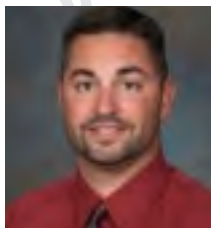


# A Message From The Principal

## Head Coach Bio: Jarrod Linn

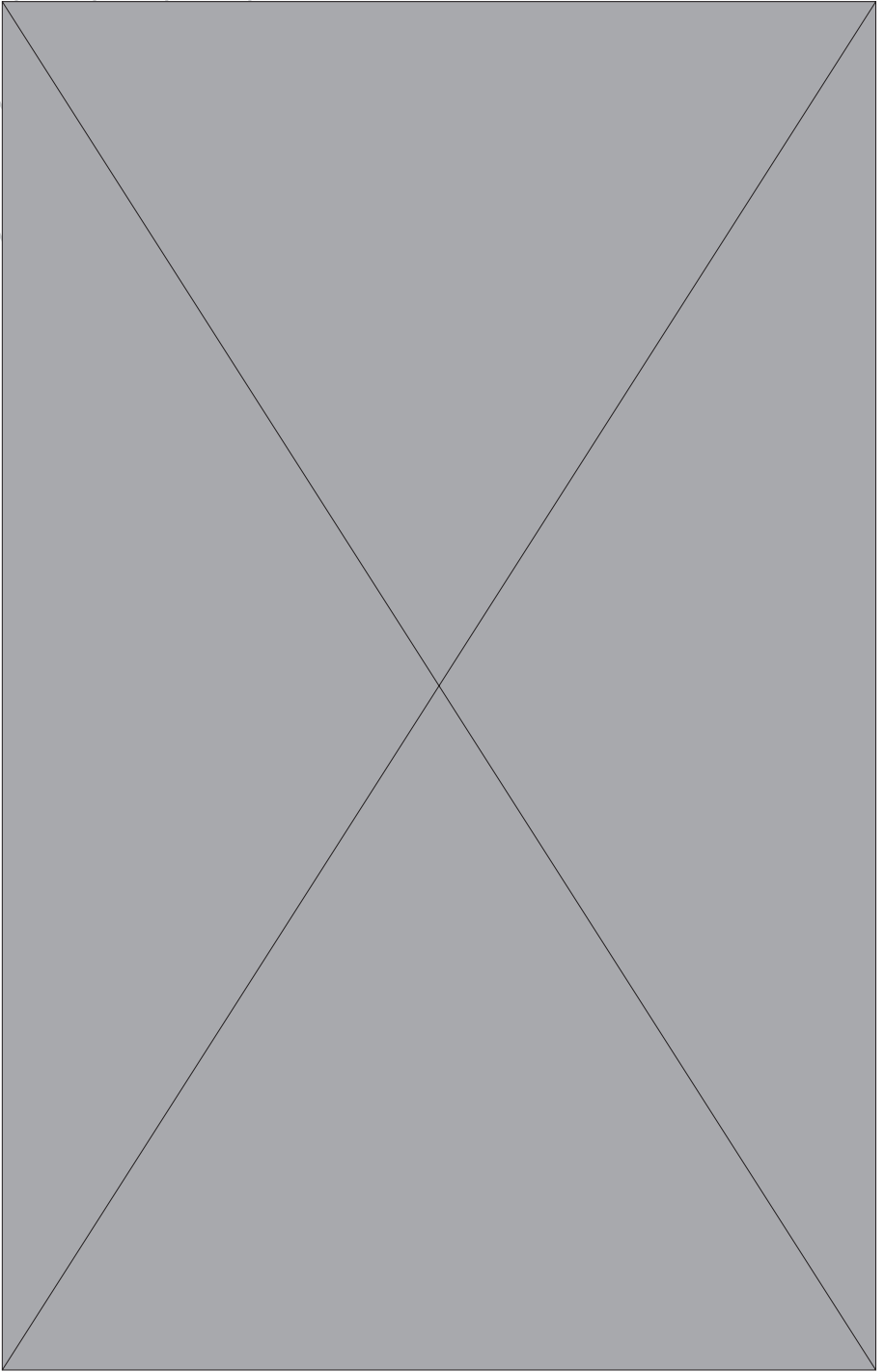
