This program has a proud history of competing at the highest level, traveling to national competitions for over 20 years and consistently proving that our athletes can hold their own against the best in the country. The pinnacle came in 2015 when New Oxford claimed a National Cheerleading Championship, an achievement that still inspires today's athletes to push harder, aim higher, and honor the legacy of those who came before them. In 2024, we continued to make our mark by finishing 6th in the nation, a testament to the dedication, discipline, and heart that have always been the backbone of this team. While competition is a major part of our identity, we are equally proud to support our school through fall football cheerleading, winter cheerleading for basketball and wrestling, and year-round efforts to build spirit and community pride. Football season fills our sidelines with theme nights and music from the band that inspires creative dances, while winter brings the thrill of indoor stunting and crowd-leading. 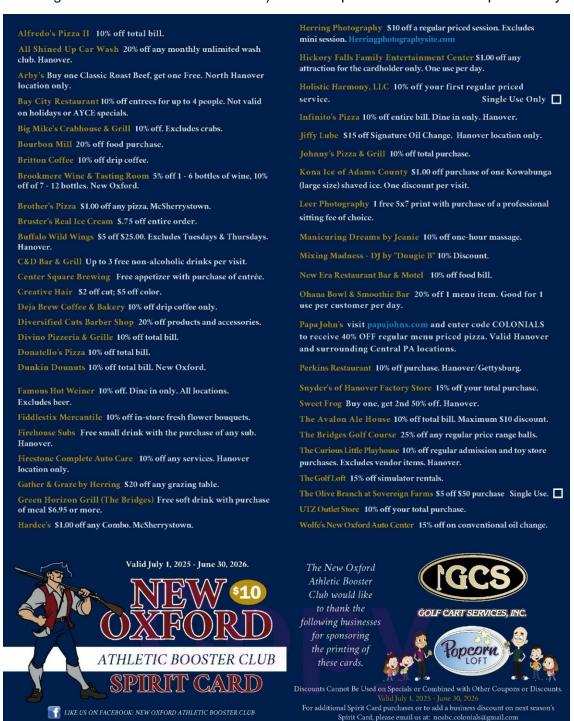
