



# Girls Basketball



# Wrestling

The wrestling program has been taken over by newly hired head coach, Kyle Flickinger. A 2005 graduate of Bermudian Springs, Coach Flickinger made two appearances at the PIAA State Tournament. He went on to wrestle at York College where he compiled 114 wins, qualified for the NCAA Division 3 Championships two times, placing 6th and becoming an All-American in 2007. After graduating in 2009, Coach Flickinger began coaching at York College as an assistant for 10 years, helping to coach multiple NCAA qualifiers and All-Americans. He was later inducted into the York College Athletic Hall of Fame in 2021.

In 2017 Coach Flickinger got involved with coaching the New Oxford Youth Wrestling program and has spent the past two years as the assistant coach on the junior high team, working with Coach Travis Martin. Now the two are taking over the high school team and are looking forward to creating a new culture and bringing their mindset to the next level.

A young, determined group of New Oxford wrestlers are ready to take on some big challenges in the 2025-2026 season. The lineup of new coaches are eager to push these guys and girls to new levels. The future of the wrestling program looks bright, with many talented wrestlers at the elementary, junior high, and high school levels. We are excited to see this new wave of hard-working student athletes in action this winter.
